

1. Regular Cleaning:

- Clean the tracks:** Vacuum the tracks to remove loose dirt and debris, then wash them with warm soapy water and a soft brush or cloth.
- Clean the frame:** Wash the aluminium frame with warm soapy water and a soft cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners that can scratch the finish.
- Clean the glass:** Use a glass cleaner and a soft cloth to clean the glass panels.

2. Lubrication:

- Identify moving parts:** The tracks and rollers are the main areas that need lubrication.

- Look for misalignment:** Ensure the door is properly aligned and doesn't stick or rub against the frame.
- Address issues promptly:** If you notice any problems, address them promptly to prevent further damage or issues.
